Sharing files using Office 365



You can share files with other people around the University using **365.lincoln.ac.uk**. It's important that you share using the right method to make sure your files are secure.

There are two options for sharing files:

Teams



What is it and why should I use it?

- Create a Team for a specific group of people to share and store files, have conversations about your work and collaborate in real time.
- Keep all your Team's files in one place with 1TB of available storage.
- Everybody in your team will have access to files and conversations, meaning no need to set specific permissions.

Top Tips

- Make sure you choose the right type of team. The "Anyone" option will share files with anybody in the University.
- Don't use sensitive information in your Team's name - team names can be seen by anybody in the University.
- Add the right people to your Team. Once someone is a member, they can see everything in the Team.
- Choose the correct owners. Owners have extra permissions to make changes to a Team.
- Public groups are visible to the whole University, whereas Private groups are only visible to group members.

OneDrive



What is it and why should I use it?

- OneDrive is a cloud-based personal file store, allowing you to store files safely and securely and access them from any device, anywhere.
- Keep all of your files in one place with 1TB of storage available.
- Files can be shared with internal and external contacts. You can choose which files to share, and who to share them with

Top Tips

- When you add a file to your OneDrive, files are only visible by you by default.
- You can share a file or folder by clicking the sharing button and choosing who to give access to.



- Remember If you share a folder, all files in the folder will also be shared, including any new files.
- Files and Folders can be shared with an individual, or group of people.
